Schedule

- Hours are after school-6:00 p.m.
- Three and five-day options

Fantastic Friends will be in session on most Carnegie Parent/Teacher Conference and Professional Development days from 7:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. **These days are included in your tuition.** (You may be asked to provide a few dollars to cover field trips on those days.)

We are not in session on the Thursday of Fall Break or on Good Friday.

We follow Tulsa Public School closings on inclement weather days.

Transportation



Weather permitting, children walk from school to the church with the staff. We do have a van available when needed.

New Haven does not make transportation arrangements for activities that occur after school (Scouts, tutoring, etc.) Parents are responsible for arranging this transportation.

Tuition

Registration/Materials \$100

Three days \$175/mth

Monday-Friday \$250/mth

Monthly tuition is based on the total number of days in session divided by nine. This results in nine equal payments regardless of “short” or “long” months. Pre-enrollment for the next school year is held in March. A minimum deposit of \$50 is due at that time along with the registration form and a copy of the child’s updated immunization record. This deposit is non-refundable. The balance is due by the last day of school in May of the current school year. That first payment serves as your DECEMBER tuition. The Aug/Sept tuition payment is due the first day of school. The remaining payments are due monthly thereafter (excluding December). **Tuition is due on the first school day of each month.** A late charge of \$25.00 will be assessed on payments received after the 10th of the month. Missed days are not refundable.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Withdrawal during the school year requires a **two-week notice.** Tuition that has been paid beyond those two weeks will be refunded.



Parent Involvement

Parents are always welcome at New Haven! We have a Parent Resource Center full of helpful books and other information. There is also a parent bulletin board to help keep you informed about the program. We offer parent-teacher conferences as well as an annual parent survey. Our Parent’s Association is very active and plays a very important role in our school. They plan several events throughout the year and encourage all parents to be involved.
