Early Childhood Program

Young Toddlers (9-15 months)

A loving, nurturing environment helps children explore and grow in what is often their first experience away from home.

Activities promote:

- ♥ Language development through reading, songs, and puppetry
- ♥ Fine and gross motor development
- ♥ Social development through interaction with both adults and other children
- ♥ Creative expression through music, art, and sensory experiences

Children in this class must be 9 months old by September 1. Teacher/child ratio is 2 adults to 6 children.

Older Toddlers (16-23 months) & Twos

A secure, caring environment helps each child learn new concepts and enjoy new experiences. Children this age are still mainly engaging in parallel play, but have the opportunities for socialization and cooperative play in group settings.

Activities are appropriate to their rapidly developing physical, language, and cognitive skills and include:

- ♥ Art and music
- ♥ Fine and gross motor activities
- ♥ Emphasis on self help skills, such as washing hands and opening lunches
- ♥ Outdoor and indoor play
- ♥ Reading and puppetry
- ♥ Creative and movement games

Teacher/child ratio is 2 adults to 8 children for the older toddlers and 2 adults to 10 children for 2-year-olds.

Preschool Program

Threes & Pre-Kindergarten

Preschoolers are aware of the world around them. They are capable of self-directed activities and also enjoy participating in group activities. Emphasis is on the development of the individual child as he/she operates in a group.

Preschool classrooms are arranged into learning centers in which children make choices and work together. The teacher acts as a facilitator who encourages child-centered activities that promote:

- ♥ Fine and gross motor skills
- ♥ Hands-on problem solving and exploration (science & math)
- ♥ Creative expression through art, music, dramatic play, puppetry
- ♥ Reading and story telling
- ♥ Increased participation in groups
- ♥ Self-help skills such as hand washing, opening lunches, table manners, bathroom skills, and putting on and zipping coats.
- ♥ Threes & Pre-K children also have weekly Chapel as well as Spanish and computer classes.

Teacher/child ratio is 1 adult to 10 children for 3-year-olds and 1 adult to 11 children for Pre-K classes.

Children are placed based on their age as of September 1 of the current school year.

Monthly tuition is based on the total number of days in session divided by nine, which results in nine equal payments for the school year. Pre-enrollment for the next school year is held in March. The non-refundable \$50 registration fee is due at that time along with the registration form and a copy of the child's updated immunization record. The first month's tuition is due by the last day of school in May of the current school year. That first payment serves as your DECEMBER tuition. The Aug/Sept tuition payment is due the first day of school. The remaining payments are due monthly thereafter (excluding December). **Tuition is due on the first school day of each month.** A late charge of \$25.00 will be assessed on payments received after the 10th of the month. Missed days are not refundable.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Withdrawal from the program requires a two-week notice. Tuition that has been paid beyond those two weeks will be refunded.
